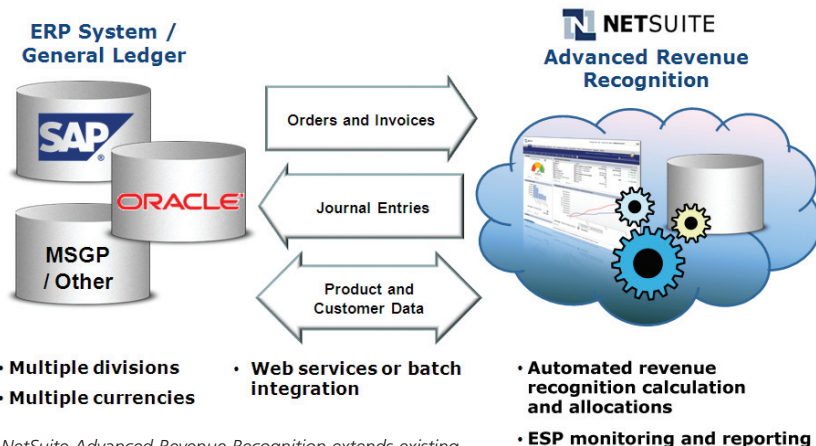

It also accommodates the requirements of SOP 97-2 and 98-9 on Vendor Specific Objective Evidence (VSOE), including the Residual Method and a separate VSOE price for every item.

With NetSuite Advanced Revenue Recognition, you can automatically recognize revenue for each line item according to the appropriate revenue recognition method.

Effective Revenue Recognition Management on Multi-Element Sales

With NetSuite Advanced Revenue Recognition, you can automatically track and support “units of accounting” and selling prices by VSOE, ESP, and Third-Party Evidence (TPE) for all elements of multiple-element arrangements. It enables automatic reallocation of order value to each line item, and you gain the flexibility to customize schedules on a per-item basis.

Additionally for EITF 08-01, NetSuite Advanced Revenue Recognition enables you to track and manage ESPs for every SKU across multiple business dimensions such as channel and geography. You can monitor accuracy by comparing actual selling prices versus ESPs, and get exception reports vital for ESP accuracy.

Flexible Revenue Recognition Capabilities

NetSuite Advanced Revenue Recognition supports revenue recognition schedules for all sales transactions and provides immediate notification when revenue is due to be recognized. It enables you to recognize revenue as a job is completed, thanks to support for percentage of completion-based revenue recognition. You can also:

- Recognize revenue using a separate process from billing
- Use an integrated workflow for simultaneous revenue recognition and billing
- Manage one-off and recurring billing processes for subscription and maintenance-based revenue streams
- Meet global business management needs with multi-currency and multi-subsidiary intelligence.

Integration with SAP, Oracle or NetSuite Financials

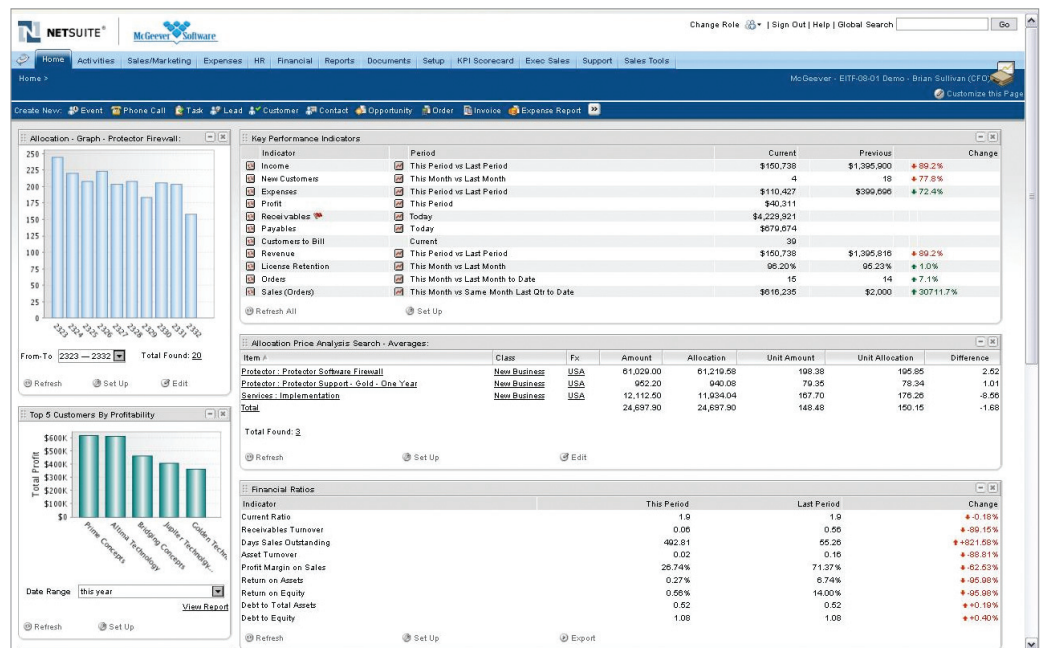


Clear Reporting, Visibility and Monitoring
